How Can I Join?

Eligibility: Students must be enrolled at one of our partner institutions as an undergraduate or graduate students for the duration of the program. Applicants must have a passport valid for at least 6 months.

Applying Process: Nomination (Partner Univ.) → Application (By Students) → Payment (Invoice to Students) → Admission → Study at SISS II!

STEP **01** Nomination (from April 1st to May 31st, 2024)

The International offices of UOS partner universities are asked to nominate candidate(s) at http://oia.uos.ac.kr.

STEP **02** Application (from April 1st to June 15th, 2024)

Nominated students are required to complete the UOS on-line application at http://oia.uos.ac.kr.

STEP **03** Payment (from April 1st to June 15th, 2024)

Payment information will be provided to Applicants during application period.

STEP **04** Admission (by June 30th, 2024)

Upon completion of the review of application and payment, UOS uploads the admission packages (soft copy) on the webpage of <u>CHECK STATUS</u> on Eligibility & Application. Applicants can download it by oneself. We can send the hard copy only upon request.


Refund Policy

Please be advised that all refund requests must be submitted in writing to our summer school team. The registration fee is non-refundable. Refunds will be processed within 3-4 weeks of receipt of a valid request.

For tuition refunds, the following policies apply:

- If a student withdraws by June 24, which is one week prior to the start of the program, the tuition will be refunded less any commission fees or bank transaction charges.
- 50% of the tuition fee will be refundable before the start of the program, less any commission fees or bank transaction charges.
- From the official start of the program, no refund will be available. A written notice
 of withdrawal must be made to the office before the deadline in order to receive the
 refund. If a student does not appear in class during the first week, the student's admission will be canceled and no refunds will be issued.
