

Eligibility

To qualify as an exchange student at Osaka University of Commerce (OUC), you need to meet the following requirements:

- Be enrolled at one of OUC's partner institutions
- Be formally nominated as an exchange student by your home institution

Application Deadlines

The application must arrive at OUC NO LATER than the deadlines below.

2022 Fall Admission: April 30, 2022

2023 Spring Admission: September 30, 2022

Application Documents

- (1) OUC Student Exchange Application Form with a photo attached (4cm×3cm)
- (2) Application for Certificate of Eligibility
- (3) Official copy of transcripts
- (4) A photocopy of your passport (the page with your name and passport number)
- (5) Certificate confirming the applicant's bank account balance
- (6) Copy of TOEFL score (Only for applicants whose native language is not English)
 - * Some other documents may be requested depending on the applicant's country or personal situation.

Important Notes

- Incomplete applications will not be processed.
- Applications sent directly by students will not be accepted.
- Your application will be reviewed by the selection committee at OUC.
- Acceptance to OUC is confirmed once; your home institution's International Office receives your acceptance letter.
- Extending your study period is not permitted in principle. Please plan and choose your study period very carefully when you apply.

Japanese Language Requirement

There is no Japanese proficiency required to apply to be an exchange students at OUC.

*Applicants whose native language is not English must submit a copy of their TOEFL score.

Housing

OUC provides off-campus housing for all exchange students. It is in a very convenient location, within walking distance of the OUC campus and close to supermarkets and convenience stores.

Student Visa

Exchange students must obtain a Student Visa in order to study at OUC. Exchange Students will need a Certificate of Eligibility (COE) to apply for a Student Visa at the Japanese Embassy or Consulate in their home country. The Student Visa will be valid for the length of one full term at OUC.

Certificate of Eligibility

The Certificate of Eligibility (COE) is an official document issued by the Japanese Ministry of Justice. After students are admitted to study at OUC, the Office of Comprehensive Education & Exchange (International Office) will apply for your Certificate of Eligibility on your behalf. Once the Certificate of Eligibility (COE) has been issued by the Immigration Services Agency of Japan, it will be sent to the students. Students need to apply for a Student Visa at the nearest Japanese Embassy or Consulate in their home country prior to arrival in Japan. We recommend that you do not purchase a plane ticket prior to issuance of the Certificate of Eligibility (COE).





When will the Certificate of Eligibility be mailed?

Your Certificate of Eligibility will be mailed out in January for Spring semester applicants, and in July for Fall semester applicants.

Financial requirement (for one month)

Under the exchange agreement, exchange students will pay tuition only at their home university. Exchange students will be responsible for all other fees required for attending the host Institution.

- **※1:** You pay ¥48,800 out of ¥78,800 for Housing & Meal Plan to OUC. Lunch is not included in Meal Plan.
- **※2**: You need to pay bed linen fees when you check-in the accommodation. (About ¥20,000)
- *3: Meals are not provided on Saturdays, Sundays and national holidays. You must prepare the meals on your own. You have to pay for the cost of meals yourself on Saturdays, Sundays and national holidays. The average cost of a meal on/off campus is ¥500-1,000 per meal.
- ***4**: Utility expenses depend on how much you spend.
- ****5:** There is no need to commute because the housing is located within walking distance of the OUC campus.
- ****6:** Personal expenses (e.g. Mobile phone, souvenirs, living ware, etc...) may differ, depending on the student's lifestyle and off-campus activities.

Purchase a plane ticket

All exchange students to OUC must purchase a plane ticket on their own. Please inform us of the flight schedule when you purchase a ticket. OUC staff will pick you up at the airport in Osaka, Japan. OUC does not offer a ride to the airport, so exchange students need to go to the airport at their own expense when leaving.

Insurance

All exchange students to OUC must purchase overseas travel insurance in their country on their own before their departure. They must submit a copy of the certificate of insurance.
