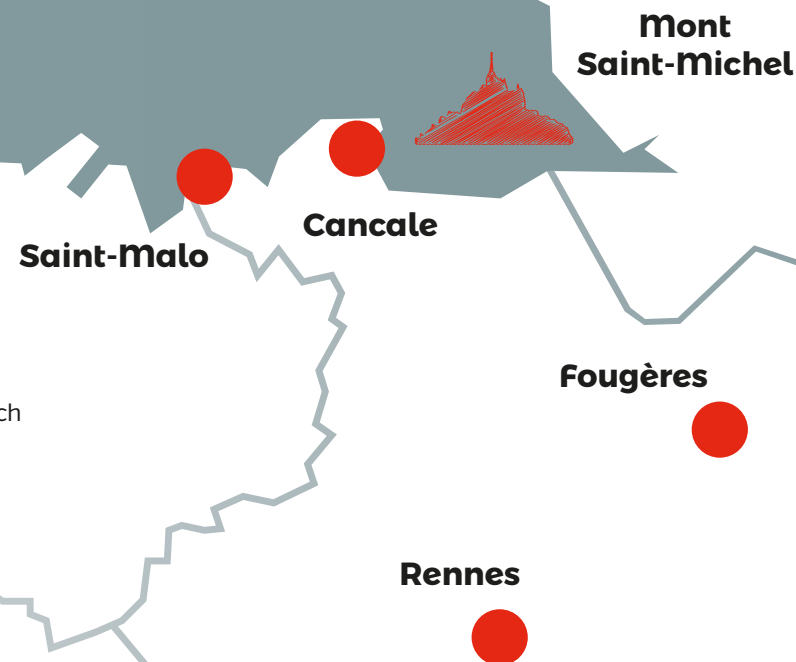
“Fête de la musique”
