- Brazil is the sixth most populous country in the world, with over 214 million people (World Bank, 2021), most of whom are descendants of Indigenous Peoples, Europeans and Africans;

- The current population is over 10 million;
- Bounded by the Atlantic Ocean, São Paulo, Santa Catarina, Mato Grosso do Sul, Argentina, Paraguay and the Paraná River;
- Home to the Araucaria forest, one of the world's most valuable subtropical forests;
- Home of the Iguazú National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site;
- Hub of cultural and religious diversity, consolidated by centuries of coexistence of different ethnic groups.

CURITIBA



- The current population is around 2 million;
- Model city for urban planning;
- Example to other cities for its creativity in urban design solutions and its technology in urban transport;
- The public transport system (Bus Rapid Transit) created in Curitiba in the 1970s has been exported across the globe.



- Memorials, churches and monuments dedicated to the immigrants;
- Extensive green areas and a diverse fauna and rich flora: 64.5 m² of green space per inhabitant;
- 45 Urban Parks and Woods;
- 75 Museums;
- 38 Theatres - “Curitiba International Theatre Festival”.

- One of the 21 smartest communities in the world, and the only city in Latin America to enter the Intelligent Community Forum ranking (2022).








HISTORY OF PUCPR





- Founded in 1959 as the Universidade Católica do Paraná;
- In 1973, the Marist Brothers took over the administration of the University, and from that moment onwards, the University incorporated the principles and values of Saint Marcellin Champagnat, founder of the Marist Brothers Congregation.



HISTORY OF PUCPR

- In 1985, the Sacred Congregation for Catholic Education bestowed upon the University the title of **Pontifical**, recognizing its commitment to **quality, Christian values and solidarity.**








Faculty member who acts as a key player for internationalization strategy

Modalities for International Mobility

- Credit-based: 1 or 2 semesters;
- Culture/Language: 3 weeks during academic holidays;
- Short-term: 7 to 30 days;
- International internship.


- Tuition exemption while abroad;

- PUCPR is pioneer in introducing English as medium of instruction in Brazil, and has the largest number of courses taught in English;

- Offered to both international and local academic community.




- First initiative to offer Liberal Arts education in Brazil, following the North American model, in partnership with Kent State University;
