1,0; 1,3	sehr gut (very good)
1,7; 2,0; 2,3	gut (good)
2,7; 3,0; 3,3	befriedigend (satisfactory)
3,7; 4,0	ausreichend (sufficient)
4,3; 4,7; 5,0	mangelhaft (fail)

ECTS grading scale

(copied from European Commission: ECTS Users' Guide, 1995)

ECTS grades	% of successful students normally achieving the grade	Definition
A	10	Excellent - outstanding performance with only minor errors
B	25	Very good - above the average standard but with some errors
C	30	Good - generally sound work with a number of notable errors
D	25	Satisfactory - fair but with significant shortcomings
E	10	Sufficient - performance meets the minimum criteria
FX	-	Fail - some more work required before the credit can be awarded
F	0	Fail - considerable further work is required

ECTS credits:

1 full academic year = 60 credits

1 semester = 30 credits
